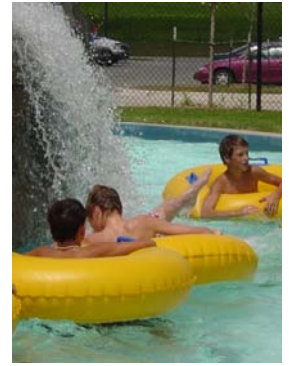




2011 - 2012 CONTINUING EDUCATION UNIT AQUATIC WORKSHOPS



Staying on the cutting edge of advances in our field is vital in the operation of aquatic facilities in this day and time. Recognizing this fact, the Iowa Park and Recreation Association is dedicated to providing eleven half-day workshops which address both updated information in addition to your individual questions and concerns. This workshop will break each of these issues down and find methods for avoiding and resolving problems and concerns in your facility. This year's workshops will focus on:

- **CDC - MAHA** – Center for Disease Control (CDC) is rapidly moving toward national standards through its Model Aquatic Health Code. Receive the most updated knowledge affecting your facility.
- **CODE REVIEW** – Iowa Department of Public Health has an extensive swimming pool and spa code. This session will discuss what the “hot” button code issues were from summer 2011 as well as possible changes for code revisions.
- **ADA COMPLIANCE** – Is your facility American's with Disabilities Act compliant? You may think so, but our staff will share insider tips to ensure patron service.
- **QUESTION & ANSWERS** – Past participants find this one of the best sessions. Learn insider tips while networking with fellow classmates.

The workshops are based on meeting the needs of the participants. The format is extremely flexible and focuses on “real problems in the real world”. Participants are encouraged to come with questions for our knowledgeable staff to answer.

The workshop will be lead by experts in the swimming pool and spa industry. Our teaching staff includes individuals with up-to-date education in state-of-the-art technology, extensive experience in construction of new and refurbished facilities as well as hands-on experience in all facets of pool operation. Their broad background and ability to relate to class members' questions combine for an outstanding educational experience.

In addition to being an excellent source of information, *this workshop has been approved by the Iowa Department of Public Health for 2.5 hours of continuing education* in accordance with part 641-12.11(2) of the Iowa Health Code which requires all Certified Pool Operators to receive an average of at least two hours of CEU's per year in a five year period concurrent with the individual's CPO certification. This CEU Workshop does not update your Certified Pool Operator license as issued by the National Swimming Pool and Spa Foundation.

The workshop will begin at 1:00 p.m. and end at 4:15 p.m. **Exception is Workshop #7 which will be held Wednesday, April 4 from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM.** The fee is \$110.00 for Non-Iowa Park & Recreation Association members and \$100.00 for Iowa Park & Recreation Association members.
